

## Mackay 1939 Obituary for John Sutherland Mackay

From the Vancouver Sun for 9 March 1939:

"John Sutherland Mackay, pioneer barrister of the Northwest and a veteran of the Klondike Gold Rush died today at his home at 998 Thurlow Street. His wife and his sister at Edmonton survive him. Mr. Mackay, a member of the legal firm of Mackay and Fraser was born at Woodstock, Ontario, graduated at Osgoode Hall and came west in the late 1890's going to the Klondike in 1898 over the old Edmonton trail. He became Registrar of the territorial court of the Yukon Territory, holding that post until he came to Vancouver in 1910. For some years, he was a member of the firm of Gwillam, Crisp and Mackay. Mr. Gwillam was killed overseas and Mr. Crisp died in 1924. Mr. Mackay in the following year went into partnership with Bruce Fraser."
