Note: The main sources for this document were the Henderson's Directories for 1908 on and the *Edmonton Bulletin* and *Edmonton Journal* newspapers. Henderson Directories was a company based in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Street numbers rise as you move south to north. Avenue numbers rise as you move east to west. The structures listed in this document may or may not still exist. Normally, the person listed as living at a residence was the owner but this is not always the case.

In 1924, the following were recorded in the Henderson Directory for this location: Hugh R. Millen, janitor at Parkdale School, and Edgar Millen, member of the Royal Canadian Northwest Mounted Police, and Christina Millen, steno for the Solder Settlement Board. There were four children of Hugh Rankin Millen: John born 1899 in Ireland, Edgar born 1901 in Ireland, Christine born 1904 in Ireland and Annie born 1909 in Canada.

85th Street (North side of 112th Avenue to South Side of 118th Avenue)

In 1930, James F. Clark, a plumber for H. Kelly and Company, lived here.

11211-85th Street – Multi-storey Apartment Building

This was built in 1989.

11212-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, William Anhal lived here.

11216—85th Street – Residence

In 1930, William Ougden, a plumber for H. Kelly and Company, lived here.

11219-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Nellie G. Michael lived here.

11221-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, William Croft lived here.

11234-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Henry J. Tatnall, a clerk for the railway mail service, lived here.

11238-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Septimus B. Baker, a car man for the CPR, lived here. Septimus Barnard Baker was born in 1900 in Northamptonshire, England in 1900. His parents were John Baker (1861-) and Ada (1863-) both born in England, family immigrated to Canada in 1913.

11251-85th Street – Residence

This was built in 1958. Various generations of the Bundred family have lived there.

11302-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, James J. Chamberlain lived there.

11310-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Albert Myles, a yard man for Capital City Box, lived here.

11316-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Stuart Hay, a mechanic for Dominion Motors, lived here.

11322-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Clarence A. Gogan, the Secretary Treasurer for Capital Shoe Manufacturing, lived here.

11324-85th Street – Residence

This house was built in 1950.

11328-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Walter Ewenson, a service manager at Dominion Motors, lived here. There is a record of a Walter Ewenson living in 1950 at 11004-82nd Street, perhaps the same person.

11335-85th Street – Community

This is the Cromdale Parkdale Community League Building, which was opened on 15 September 1982.

11338-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Mrs. Daisy Zyteruk lived here.

11403-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Herbert J. Smith, a driver for NW Biscuit, lived here.

11407-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, John McConnell, a night man for the Provincial Government, worked here.

11415-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Merrill D. Muttart, manager of Muttart Lumber, lived here.

11421-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, William F. Podgurny, a salesman for Northwest Oils, lived here.

11422-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Mrs. M. Clark lived here.

11428-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Norm Mahaffy, meat inspector for Swifts, lived here.

11435-85th Street – Residence

This house was built in 1953.

11438-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Jesse Boak, drayman, lived here. Note: A drayman was historically the driver of a dray, a low, flat-bed wagon without sides, pulled generally by horses or mules

11501-85th Street – Business

In 1930, a grocery store run by Oliver Brindley was located here.

11505-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Oliver Brindley lived here. Oliver Brindley was born in England in 1872. He married Adeline Frances Thrackaberry in Edmonton on 23 June 1907.

11507-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Harry V. Coles, who worked at Alberta Motors, lived here.

11510-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, John Gargett, a shipper at McLennan and Company, lived here.

11514-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, William Shand lived here.

11516-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, this house was vacant.

11520-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Arthur Scheer, a Provincial Brand Inspector, lived here.

11522-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Alex Connolly, city clerk, lived here.

11524-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, William Coupland, a waiter at the Canadian Legion, lived here.

11527-85th Street – Residence

This house was built in 1917. It has a porch. In 1930, John Skinner, a blacksmith at Fane Auto Works, lived here.

11528-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Henry Christman, a meat inspector at Swifts, lived here.

11532-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, John Gish, a shipper at Western Steel Products, lived here.

11534-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, John Bradshaw, a CNR employee lived here.

11535-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, John E. Geddes, who worked for Woodland Dairy, lived here.

11601-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Thomas Adby, who did repair work for CPR, lived here.

11603-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, William Worobec, labourer, lived here.

11615-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Edward Hawton lived there.

11617-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, David J. Mellan, Department Assistant at Swifts, lived here.

11621-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, David E. Wheatcroft, a brand inspector for the Provincial Government, lived here.

11623-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Mrs. Marion Macaulay lived here.

11627-85th Street – Residence

This two-storey house was built in 1920. In 1930, William Blackwell, a driver for Smith's Cartage, lived there.

11631-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Thomas Stewart, gas shovel operator, lived here.

11641-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Samuel W. Locke, an employee of Western Grain Inspections, lived here.

11648-85th Street - School

In 1930, Henry W. White, pay master, lived here.

11705-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Robert Morris, manager for Alberta Dairy Supply Limited, lived here.

11709-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Mrs. Jessie A. Storrie, lived here.

11711-85th Street – Residence

This house was built in 1949.

11716-85th Street – Residence

This two-storey house was built in 1917. In 1930, Mrs. Mary E. McClure, lived here.

11717-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Hamilton Skaggs, a salesman for Beatty Brothers, lived here. Hamilton Skaggs was born on 11 July 1882 in Lawrence County, Kentucky, USA. He died on 20 July 1960 in Edmonton. His father was Lewis Boss Skaggs (1861-1906) and his mother was Susan Ison (1861-1894).

11718-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Archibald Helm, a salesman for Burns and Company, lived here.

11722-85th Street – Residence

Mrs. Margaret Stump lived here in 1930.

11728-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Edward H. McDonald, builder, lived here.

11729-85th Street – Residence

In 1930, Martin L. Carter, carpenter for the CNR, lived here.

86th Street (North Side of 112th Avenue to South Side of 118th Avenue)

11333-86th Street – Residence

The current structure at this address was built in 2012.

11339-86th Street – Residence

This house was built in 1946.

11725-86th Street – Residence

This house was built in 1912.

87th Street (North Side of 112th Avenue to South Side of 118th Avenue)

11217-87th Street – Residence

This was built in 1920. It is a two-storey structure that has been more recently converted into a triplex.

11446-87th Street – Residence

The current structure at this address was built in 2008. It is a duplex.

88th Street (North Side of 112th Avenue to South Side of 118th Avenue)

11549-88th Street – Residence

This home was built in 1946.

11620-88th Street – Residence

This home was built in 1925.

11724-88th Street – Residence

This two-story house was built in 1924.

11720-88th Street – Residence

This house was built in 1914.

89th Street (East Side of Street from North Side of 112th Avenue to South Side of 118th Avenue)

11305-89th Street – Residence

At some point in 1920 or before, this home was occupied by James McLuhan and Margaret (Grieve) McLuhan. They came to Alberta from Mount Forest, Ontario in 1906 and farmed in the Mannville area before moving into Edmonton. Margaret Grieve was born in Scotland and James McLuhan was born in Ireland.

112th Avenue (North Side of Avenue from CNR tracks to East Side of 89th Street)

8714-112th Avenue – Residence

This house was built in 1947.

113th Avenue (CNR Tracks to East Side of 89th Street)

114th Avenue (CNR Tracks to East Side of 89th Street)

114th Avenue was known as Spruce Avenue before 1914.

8117-114th Avenue – Low-rise Apartment Building

This was built in 2009.

8201-114th Avenue – Business

In 1930, the R.P. Graves Lumber Company was located here.

8401-114th Avenue – Church

In 1930, the Free Methodist Church was located here.

8405-114th Avenue – Residence

In 1930, the Reverend W. P. Carmichael lived here.

8502-114th Avenue – Residence

In 1930, Fred Gardner lived here.

8730-114th Avenue – Residence

In 1930, Mrs. Sarah B. Cram lived here.

8812-114th Avenue – Residence

In 1930, John Turik lived there.

8820-114th Avenue – Residence

In 1930, this house was vacant.

115th Avenue (CNR Tracks to East Side of 89th Street)

116th Avenue (80th Street to East Side of 89th Street)

Note: Prior to 1914, 116th Avenue was known as Chown Avenue.

8404-116th Avenue – Residence

This structure was built in 1967.

117th Avenue (CNR Tracks to East Side of 89th Street)

118th Avenue (South side of Avenue from CNR Tracks to East Side of 89th Street)

Note: 118th Avenue was known officially as Alberta Avenue before 1914.

8012-118th Avenue – Business

Action Muffler Radiator & Brakes is located here in 2012.

8115-118th Avenue – Business

The Cromdale Hotel opened in 1954. For additional information, see:

Fort Road

Note: The Fort Road used to connect Edmonton and Fort Saskatchewan.

11424-Ford Road – Public Park

The Edgar Millen Public Park is located here. Edgar (Spike) Millen was the Royal Canadian Mounted Police officer who was killed on 30 January 1932 by Albert Johnson, the Mad Trapper of Rat River. Edgar Millen studied at Parkdale School from 1913-1920. Edgar Millen was born in 1901 in Ireland and migrated to Canada with his parents at an early age. Constable Millen is buried in Beechmont Cemetery in Edmonton. His father and mother were Hugh Rankin Millen (1864-1942) and Mary Margaret Edgar (1874-1930). There is additional information on the Millen family under the entry for 11731-84th Street.

11502-Fort Road – Business
